## What to Document

3rd Character: Type of intestinal infectious disease

4th Character: Cholera

### Document:

-Any resistance to anti-microbial drugs

### Terminology:

**Cholera:** A intestinal bacterial disease classified by severe diarrhea and vomiting. Rapid death can occur if left untreated.

## Chapter Guidelines

### 1. Certain infectious and parasitic diseases (A00-B99)

#### Includes:

*diseases generally recognized as communicable or transmissible*

*Use additional code to identify resistance to antimicrobial drugs (Z16.-)*

#### Excludes1:

*certain localized infections - see body system-related chapters*

#### Excludes2:

*carrier or suspected carrier of infectious disease (Z22.-)*

*infectious and parasitic diseases complicating pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium (O98.-)*

*infectious and parasitic diseases specific to the perinatal period (P35-P39)*

*influenza and other acute respiratory infections (J00-J22)*

A06- Amebiasis

A07- Other protozoal intestinal diseases

A08- Viral and other specified intestinal infections

**A09** Infectious gastroenteritis and colitis, unspecified
