# ICD-10-CM FY2019 Version Draft Exposure to Adverse Travel Situations (ATS) (X62-X62)

The following is a new section being considered for inclusion in the FY2019 version of the ICD-10-CM code set. This new section will appear in sequence as follows:

Code all causes, sources and information relevant to the injury. Multiple X62-X62 codes may apply

Excludes1: Mental Disorders (F01-F09)

External causes of morbidity elsewhere classified (V00-Y99)

External causes of morbidity directly related to an accident involving the mode of transportation (V00-V99)
